SHIPPING CONDITIONS

1. Rates cannot be used as proportional rates in connection with UP line haul rates.
2. No mileage or car hire allowances will be paid on shipments loaded in shipper owned or leased tank cars.
3. Rate does not include the service of weighing.
4. Rates in this tariff are subject to TCWR mileage-based Fuel Surcharge Tariff 9020-Series.
5. Each shipment shall be tendered on a Uniform Straight Bill of Lading, subject to the terms and conditions of this Contract. To the extent possible, each Bill of Lading shall contain the contract number assigned to this Contract.
6. Subject to UFC tariff 6000-Series. Also subject to Official List of Open and Prepay Stations, OPSL 6000-Series.
7. Not applicable on shipments accorded stop-off to complete loading or to partially unload. No transit privileges, including diversion or re-consignment shall be permitted without approval of TCWR or MPLI.
8. Freight bills for all shipments moving hereunder shall be issued by TCWR. All rates are in U.S. dollars.
9. In the event Customer does not ship to, or on behalf of, itself from Origin(s) to Destination(s), any third party performing any obligation of Customer under this Contract shall be considered as Customer's agent for purposes of this Contract.
10. The provisions of this Contract and information obtained in the drafting thereof are confidential and shall not be disclosed to any third party, other than a parent or subsidiary, unless disclosure is required by law.
11. This rate document is subject to TCWR & MPLI Special Arrangement Tariffs 8500-Series and TCWR & MPLI Demurrage Tariffs 8400-Series.
12. Switching charges at Origin will be absorbed up to \$300 per car. Any additional amount will be assessed to the party to receive freight bill. Rates do not absorb any other rail carrier charges, including Minnesota Commercial Railway's (MNNR) intermediate switch charge when cars are routed from beyond via the BNSF Railway (BNSF) or Canadian National Railway Company (CN).
13. It is understood that no hourly, per-mile or other car hire allowances or charges shall be paid by Carrier for shipper supplied rail cars used pursuant to this Contract. Customer warrants that it has the authority to waive such allowances or charges and shall (1) either defend Carrier against any such claims received; or (2) indemnify Carrier for payment of such allowances or charges to car owner(s).
